
## RETURNING CITIZENS ARE PEOPLE

## What PAR-Recycle Works does:

We're a nonprofit that recycles electronics in order to provide transitional employment to returning citizens.

200,000 lbs recycled  $\rightarrow$  11 jobs created  $\rightarrow$  0-percent recidivism

(from cities, schools, and businesses since 2015)

(\$10/hr starting wage)

(Stastistically, 65.5%, or 7 people, would have recidivated.)
